We welcome your family to Cornerstone Community Bible Church! Our goal is to ensure the safety of all the children, while teaching them to love and serve a wonderful God. Our children's ministry offers two distinct programs at 9am and 10am, so that parents can attend Adult Bible Study and then the Worship Service. Please review the guidelines, and feel free to talk to your child's teacher if you have any further questions.

Elevate

The **9am hour** is a more traditional Sunday school. Children develop meaningful relationships with an assigned teacher and helper for an entire thirteen week quarter. Using David C Cook's "*Bible in Life*" curriculum, children work on applying and memorizing the Bible. The last Sunday of each month, children visit the memory store! **The Memory Store** is where children turn in "shekels" to purchase a small prize for the bible verses they have memorized, throughout the month. Please see our monthly newsletter for an up-to-date list of memory verses this month.

Elevate is the curriculum for the **10am hour**, and teaches children **K-5th grade** how to apply Bible concepts to their daily lives with a fun & creative approach. Elevate is taught in three parts: a small group opening activity, a large group teaching time with skit and Bible story (Power Up), and a small group closing time to drive home the bible lesson.

And an exciting new series is released every eight weeks! Upcoming adventures include: Berry Blast Theme Park, where we learn about the Fruits of the Spirit, Super Sports Spectacular, where we will learn about one of the greatest teams of the Bible, the apostles of Christ, and Zooplosion, where we will see the Bible through the eyes of animals and how God always provides. Plus many more!

Power Up!

Power Up is an exciting time of teaching and worship in a large group! Children experience worship through singing, giving offering, praying, and listening to God's Word. The Power Up team also reinforces what is being taught in their small group classrooms. Parents are welcome to check out the worship time, which takes place from 10:20am—11am (time sometimes varies due to class activities). Parents are also provided with take home material to reinforce the Bible at home.

Discipline policy

We desire for children to have respect for God's Word and love for one another. Our discipline policy is to use a warning if children become disruptive, disrespectful or uncooperative. Any child who receives 3 warnings in one day will be brought to their parents and we will work together to have that child return the following Sunday.

Goals for Children...

- ***Kids saved*** – It is our prayer for all of our children, that they would come to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior, recognizing their sin, repenting, and believing that Jesus Christ is the only way to an everlasting life with God.
- ***Kids worship*** – As our children participate in Power Up and time in worship as a family, it is our prayer that they would experience and engage in genuine, selfless, and reverent worship of our Lord.
- ***Kids pray*** – Prayer is a way we develop our relationship with our Savior. It is our desire for our children to go to the Lord in prayer, daily, independently and as a family as they lift up their Adoration, Confessions, Thanksgivings, and Supplication (ACTS).
- ***Kids memorize*** – We must learn to commit the scriptures in our heart. It is our desire to have our children actively working at memorizing God's Word.
- ***Kids learn from God's Word*** – The Bible is where we get Truth. It is our desire that the children of Cornerstone read or are read to from God's Word on a daily basis so they can learn the truth of God's Word.
- ***Kids develop and own a biblical worldview*** – Our decisions and beliefs are molded by many different influences. It is our prayer that each of our children will stand firm in the truth of God's Word as they are faced with the many temptations and unbiblical philosophies of this world.

- ***Kids led by parents through the help of the church***— Everyone needs a spiritual leader or teacher. This is true even more so for our little ones. It is our philosophy here at Cornerstone that our parents are strongly encouraged to take their role as spiritual leaders seriously. We as a church are also held responsible for that very important role as we support and equip our parents to follow through each and every day with the most important role of their life – leading their children to Christ and keeping them there.
- ***Kids evangelize***- It is our prayer for our children in Christ, to be lead by the Holy Sprit to share their faith with family, friends, and others they are in contact with. We are to encourage and teach them to share the Gospel with the lost.
- ***Kids serve*** – Even in their youth, children can have a huge role as servants of Christ. May they actively participate in family planned service projects & church related ministries as they too can be the hands and feet of our Lord.
- ***Kids give***- As parents and spiritual leaders, we can teach our children the importance of giving, as an act of obedience as well as an expression of love and gratitude to our Lord.
